The Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry is now receiving applications for the Departmental Scholarships listed below.

1. The Dr. Robert J. Albers Memorial Scholarship

Amount: One award of \$3,200

Criteria:

- Biochemistry major
- Entering Sophomore, Junior or Senior year
- Cumulative GPA above 3.00
- Financial need may be considered
- Career interest in biochemistry (medical career does not qualify)
- Must submit a one page (100-200 word) statement of interest in biochemistry and career plans in biochemistry

2. The John A. Bolt Memorial Scholarship

Amount: Four awards of \$2,500 each

Criteria:

- Chemistry or Biochemistry major
- Entering Junior or Senior year
- Cumulative GPA above 3.00
- Financial need may be considered
- Career interest in science teaching or research preferred

3. The Peter and Margaret (Bell) DeHaan Chemistry Scholarship

Amount: One award of \$2,600

Criteria:

- Chemistry major
- Entering Junior or Senior year
- Academic achievement
- Financial need may be considered

4. The Harley A. and Julia Janssen Scholarship

Amount: One award of \$1,600

Criteria:

- Chemistry or Biochemistry major or minor
- Entering Junior or Senior year
- Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher
- Financial need may be considered
- Career interest in teaching Chemistry/Biochemistry at the secondary or college level, or secondary ed science major
- Active in the life of their department

5. **The Bruce and Alice Klanderma Scholarship**

Amount: One award of \$2,600

Criteria:

- Chemistry, Biochemistry, or Chemical Engineering major
- Entering Junior or Senior year
- Cumulative GPA of 3.8 or higher
- Prefer student who plans to attend graduate school

6. **The Pfizer Scholarship**

Amount: Five awards of \$4,100 each

Criteria:

- Chemistry, Biochemistry or Chemical Engineering major
- Entering Junior or Senior year
- Cumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher
- Active in the life of their department

7. **The Dr. Enno and Mrs. Lucile Wolhuis Chemistry Scholarship**

Amount: Three awards of \$2,200 each will be made

Criteria:

- Chemistry major
- Entering Sophomore, Junior or Senior year
- Cumulative GPA above 3.00
- Career goal in research or college-level teaching
- Financial need may be considered
