Dear Family and Friends of Engineering:

The Calvin College Engineering Department invites you to the 28th Annual Senior Projects Night on Saturday, May 5, 2012. The evening's activities will begin at 4:00 p.m. with an *Open House* in the Vermeer Engineering Projects Center and Prince Engineering Design Center. Dinner is in the Commons Dining Hall at 6:00 p.m. After dinner there will be formal presentations of all the Senior Engineering Design Projects from 7:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in various lecture halls on campus.

Tickets purchased by phone or on the web (<http://www.calvin.edu/boxoffice>) require a credit card and will be accessed a small handling fee. **Please note: Tickets for the dinner must be purchased by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 27. No exceptions.**

You may invite as guests as you would like. Many grandparents find this night to be as enjoyable as graduation. Please be aware of the following when you buy your tickets.

- DO NOT include your son or daughter who is an engineering student when ordering tickets. He or she is required to attend and therefore will be provided a ticket at no cost.
- We are working on a reservation process for assigning seats in the dining hall. At this point we anticipate that those wanting a reserved seat at dinner will be required to purchase their ticket by April 15. More information on this will be available in early March.
- The Dining Hall has round tables that seat up to eight.
