The amount available for 2011-2012 was \$1,300.

Eligibility:

1. Current Calvin student planning to enroll full time the following year.
2. History major entering junior or senior year.
3. GPA of 3.2 or higher in history courses.
4. Have established financial need in records of Calvin's financial aid office.
5. Have a proven interest and commitment to the study of one or more of the following (in order of priority):

- Asian influences in the West
- Asia
- Influences and relationships between the West and the wider world (not limited to Asia)

Applicants should fill out this form and return it to the History Department by March 16, 2012.
