This scholarship, established by the Sally and Bert de Vries family, is for students minoring in Archaeology. The purpose of this scholarship is to defray costs of participating in IDIS 340 at Calvin, which is designed to satisfy the field work requirement for the Archaeology Minor at Calvin College.  
**Two awards of \$2,500 each will be given for 2011-2012.**

## *Eligibility:*

1. Current Calvin College student in any class level who is planning to enroll full time the following year.
2. Be pursuing an Archaeology Minor.
3. Financial need as defined by government programs is not required, but there should be some evidence that the scholarship is needed to help meet educational expenses.
