Visited the Hospital & Clinic



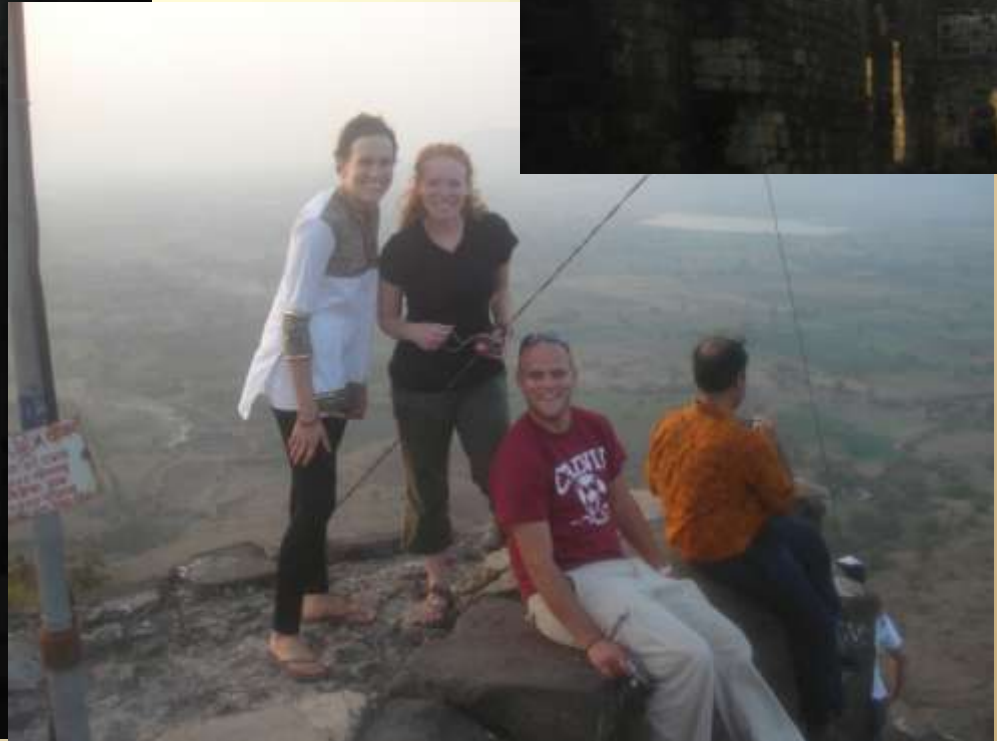
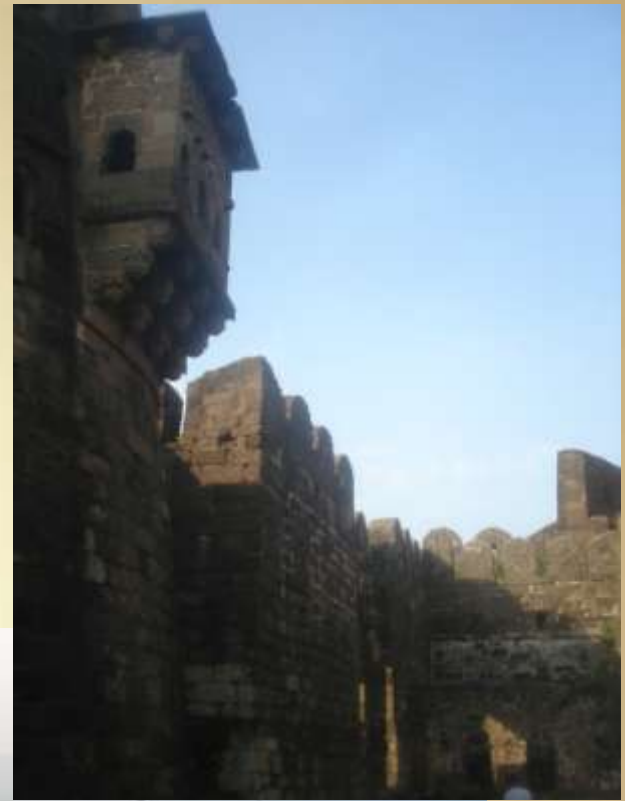
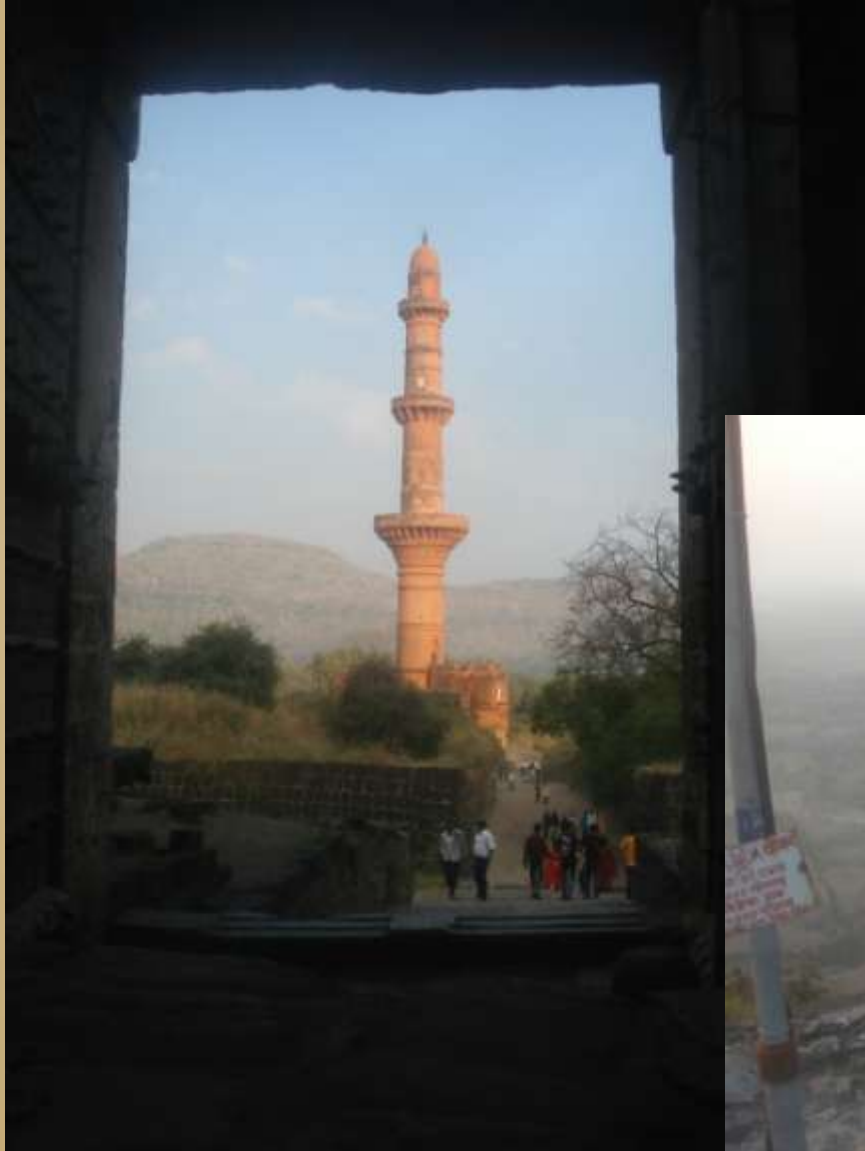
