Kenneth J. Konyndyk, Jr. taught in the Philosophy Department at Calvin College for 27 years, from 1967 - 1994, until his life's work was cut short by cancer. Dr. Konyndyk also played an instrumental role in the founding of the Society of Christian Philosophers which now numbers over 1000 in membership.
