

Application Form for the Science Division Scholarships

Eligibility: Eligible students must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher (3.3 for VanDerWoude) and must be current Calvin students planning to enroll full time the following year.

Criteria: See Science Division website (<http://calvin.edu/academic/science/scholarships/>) for the criteria of individual scholarships.

Instructions:

1. Choose **two** Calvin faculty members who have had you as a student, one of whom must be from your area of science concentration (major), to provide recommendations using the Science Division common recommendation form (available separately on the Science Division website). You must complete Part I of the recommendation form and the professor must complete Part II. Note that if you are applying for more than one Science Division and/or Science Departmental scholarship and asking the same professor for multiple recommendations, the professor need submit only one recommendation.
2. Complete this application form (including the essay—note: the same essay may be used for the Deur, Harkema, VanDerWoude and Van Oosten scholarships, but *the Zifferblatt scholarship requires a separate essay*) and return it to the Science Division Office (NH156) by **March 7, 2008**
3. All applications will be reviewed by the Science Division Scholarships Committee. Applicants will be informed of the awards by **early April**.
