Student Summer Research Fellowships
Summer 2008

- Background:** Each summer the Science Division provides opportunities for undergraduate students to engage in scientific research during the summer. These opportunities are designed to enhance student learning in the sciences while participating in independent research projects supervised by Calvin faculty.
- Research Projects** Opportunities are available to work on research projects with Calvin faculty in Biology, Chemistry/Biochemistry, Computer Science, Engineering, Geology/Geography, Mathematics/Statistics, Nursing and Physics/Astronomy.
- Who is Eligible?** Awards will be made to qualified students who will have completed their first, second, or third year of undergraduate study and who are considering a career in the sciences or mathematics. Preference will be given to those considering a career in research or teaching in those areas and to students who will be enrolled at Calvin in the fall semester.
- The Award** Students will receive a stipend of \$3700 for a 10-week period of research. Additional funds are available for project supplies.
- Expectations:** Students are expected to (1) complete the 10-weeks of research during the summer, 2007; (2) prepare a one-page research summary for the Science Division; and (3) prepare a poster for presentation at the Science Division Research Day, October, 2008.
