The student was hit over the head and a bag they were carrying was taken from them. A person matching the suspect description (B/M in their 20's, 5'5" and medium build with dark clothing) was observed near the southwest parking lot (lot 1) of campus. The Grand Rapids Police were contacted and the subject was identified.

Notes: On Tuesday, 12-6-11, Campus Safety investigated a suspicious condition at the Prince Conference Center where a guest staying there reported they were approached by a subject who demanded their wallet while they outside smoking a cigarette. The complainant said they went inside when the subject demanded their wallet. There was no further contact between the victim and the suspect. The suspect was described as a black male with a black hat and dark colored clothing. The victim also described the suspect as a Hispanic male with a red mask covering their face. The area was checked and nobody matching either description was located.

The two subjects were subsequently arrested for possession of Marijuana.

Officers checked the entire roof and building and found no signs of damage or the suspects. The building interior was also checked and was secure. The suspects were not located.
