

CHAPEL COMMITTEE

Mandate:

The Chapel Committee shall advise and assist the college chaplain and the associate chaplain for worship in carrying out all matters pertaining to the college's chapel services. The committee shall recommend policies for the college regarding such services. In carrying out this mandate, its specific duties shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

1. Promoting a lively interest and involvement in chapel services on the part of faculty, staff, and students.
2. Recommending policy to the Faculty Senate on matters such as the frequency of services, attendance, and time of services.
3. Advising and assisting the associate chaplain for worship in planning chapel services.

Reporting Relationship:

The Chapel Committee reports to the Faculty Senate.

Composition:

Twelve members: three faculty members, the college chaplain or a designee (ex officio), the vice president for student life or a designated dean from student life (ex officio), the associate chaplain for worship (ex officio) (one of these six shall be appointed chair); a resident director, to be appointed by the student life division; a member of the college's staff, to be appointed by the Committee on Governance; and four students, appointed by Student Senate, at least one of whom shall be a student chapel worship leader. Not all of the student members shall be of the same gender.
