

Calvin Alumni Association International Student Scholarships

Description of Award

The Calvin Alumni Association (CAA) International Scholarships provide funds for students who are citizens of countries outside the United States and Canada. These scholarships are available to prospective students for their first year at Calvin. The scholarships are a one-year, non-renewable award.

Scholarship recipients are selected by the Alumni Association Board and the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid. Up to three scholarships of \$2,000 are available for the 2012-13 academic year.

Award Criteria

Factors in the selection are the student's academic record, motivation, character, potential for success at Calvin, and financial need. A minimum 2.5 high school GPA is required.

To be considered for this award, students must also be formally admitted to Calvin by March 1.

Application Process

Students who wish to be considered for this scholarship must complete and submit the CAA International Student Scholarship application form by March 1, 2011.
