SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Dear Applicant:

We were happy to receive your inquiry concerning the Calvin Alumni Scholarships and we hope that you will follow through in applying.

To complete your application it is necessary that we have the enclosed materials and letter returned to us by April 15. You may mail hard-copies or e-mail the various Word documents. The following materials are needed to complete your application:

1. Application form.
2. A letter (details outlined on the application) written by the applicant stating reasons you desire to attend Calvin College.
3. Recommendation form to be filled in by either your pastor, youth leader, or elder.
4. Recommendation form to be filled in by a teacher in your major area of interest. For instance, if you are pursuing an engineering or nursing career you would choose a math or science teacher. If you are interested in a career in music you would choose a music instructor. Please note that the teacher selected should be one for an advanced course you have taken.
5. Your high school transcript and SAT / ACT scores. Be sure the transcript includes your first semester grades for your senior year.
6. If you wish to be considered for the Volunteerism Award, please complete the Volunteer Service Verification. Make as many copies as you need.

Three scholarships (\$1000 each) will be given to three high school seniors who plan to enroll at Calvin College for Fall Semester 2008. Two scholarships will be based primarily on scholastic ability and character; one will be based on a consistent pattern of volunteer service, character and requires a minimum GPA of 3.0. You must currently be a high school senior to apply.

2. Follow the standard rules for writing a business letter.
3. Include the following basic information:
 - Why do you want to attend Calvin College?
 - What course of study do you plan to pursue?
 - What are your vocational goals?
 - How can Calvin College help you attain these goals?
 - What contribution can you offer as a student at Calvin College?
