I. About the Scholarship

The Washington, DC / Baltimore Area Chapter of the Calvin Alumni Association is pleased to announce the 2008-2009 Chapter Scholarships. Through the generous contributions of Calvin alumni in the metropolitan area, and through matching funds made available by the Calvin Alumni Association, the Chapter will award one or more scholarships on behalf of the Chapter. In addition the Chapter will also award the Matt Remein Endowment Scholarship to prospective Calvin students. Any student from the metropolitan region planning to attend Calvin College for the first time in the fall of 2008, as a freshman or a transfer student, is eligible to apply for a scholarship.

The Chapter Steering Committee will select the scholarship recipient(s) based on an earned and competitive basis. Consideration will be given to Christian commitment, scholastic achievement, personal character, and professional promise. The recipient(s) will be announced in April of 2008.

II. Instructions

- A. The application deadline for the scholarship is **Friday, March 14, 2008**.
- B. Each applicant must ensure that the Steering Committee receives the following information by the application deadline:
 - ◆ The completed application form;
 - ◆ Completed reference forms from the persons the applicant identifies in Part IV; and
 - ◆ The applicant's high school transcripts.

Note: Applicants currently enrolled in a post-high course of study who are considering transferring to Calvin College should also provide college transcripts.
