

Calvin Alumni Association Grand Rapids Area Chapter Scholarship Application

Criteria

Grand Rapids Alumni Chapter Scholarships are awarded on a demonstrated and competitive basis, with consideration given to applicants who **evidence faith commitment in leadership, volunteerism and community service**. At least nine scholarships of \$2,500 each (\$1,500 for the first year and \$1,000 for the second year) will be awarded.

Applicants must be planning to enter Calvin as a first-year student in Fall 2008 and must have a minimum high school GPA of 2.5. Applicants must attend a high school in Kent County (or, if home-schooled, live in Kent County).

Application Instructions

- Only complete applications will be considered. Required documents are:
 - Completed application, including Sections 4 and 5 below.
 - Three recommendation forms from non-relatives who know you quite well and can comment accurately on your character, abilities, service involvement and faith commitment.
- Only signed and dated applications will be considered.
- Applicants are required to type their application. Applications can be downloaded as a Microsoft Word document from www.calvin.edu/alumni/scholars/chapter.htm. You may also print/type on this form, elaborating as needed on a separate sheet(s). Recommendation forms do not need to be typed.
- All applications and supporting documents must be submitted together to the Calvin Alumni Association.* Methods of submitting your completed application and supporting documents include:
