

The Paul Henry Institute Symposium on Religion and Politics

April 23 – 25, 2009

The 2009 Symposium on Religion and Politics, sponsored by the Paul Henry Institute for the Study of Christianity and Politics, will be held at the Prince Conference Center on the Calvin College Campus. The Center, which provides seminar facilities as well as overnight accommodations, is conveniently located near highway routes, as well as the Grand Rapids Gerald R. Ford International Airport.

The Symposium will begin at approximately 5:00 p.m. on April 23rd, followed by sessions and then an informal reception after the evening sessions. The schedule for Friday, April 25 will include sessions throughout the day, as well as lunch and dinner. On Saturday, panels will resume during the day, with lunch served. A more detailed schedule will be provided with your Symposium Registration Confirmation Form. The Symposium registration fee of \$50 (cash or check only) includes all meals and coffee breaks for the Symposium, including the reception on Thursday evening. Overnight Accommodations

Overnight rooms are being held for Symposium participants at the Prince Conference Center located on the Calvin College campus, ten minutes from the Gerald Ford International Airport. Shuttle transportation between the airport and the Prince Center is available with advance notification by April 17, 2009 (on the enclosed registration form, or by calling the Prince Center directly at 866-526-7200). The deadline for holding the Symposium block of rooms is March 23, 2009; after this time there may not be available on-site rooms.

All overnight rooms include either two queens or a king-size bed, as well as a complimentary deluxe continental breakfast, an on-site fitness center, cable television and free local phone calls. Please note that the entire Conference Center, including meeting space and overnight rooms, is a non-smoking site. Room costs are \$68 per night, plus 6% sales tax and 8% occupancy tax (three suites are available at a cost of \$78.00 per night plus taxes). There are a limited number of rooms at the Prince Center, so please make your reservations early.

Room reservations for the Prince Conference Center can be made with the registration form below. When choosing this option, you need not send a housing deposit; full payment will be due when you check-out, paid to the Prince Conference Center at the front desk by cash, check or credit card. Should all of the rooms at the Prince Center already be booked when we receive your reservation form, we will notify you of other available hotel accommodations in the area.
