

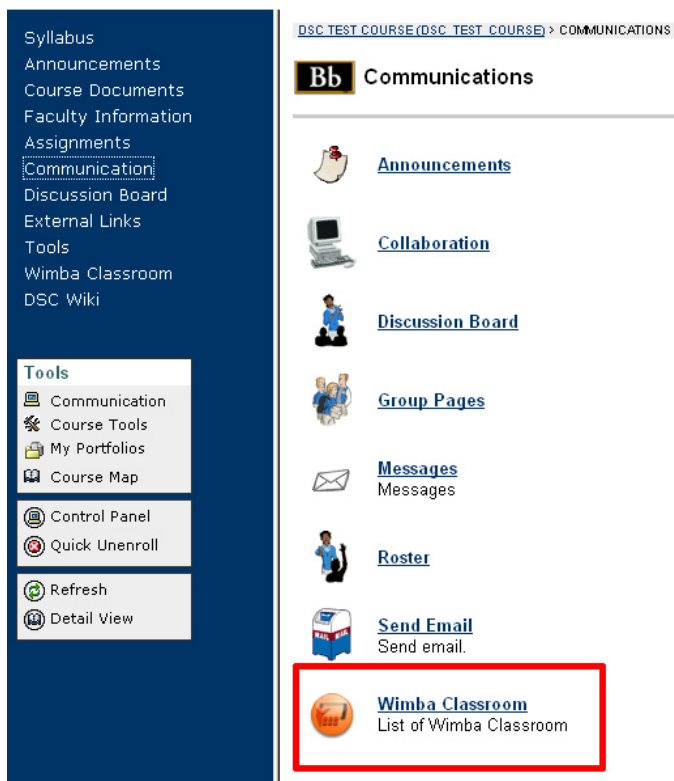
# If you are on campus or using a broadband connection, you can provide the highest quality of video while using Wimba Classroom by following these steps

- 2) Click on **Wimba Classroom**




- 3) Click on the **desired/relevant Wimba Classroom** (which you have already created and have been using)




