## Covenant

This program runs for 10 weeks. In 2012 the dates are Thursday, May 31- Tuesday, August 7 or Saturday, August 18. Monday, August 6 is the final evening session of the LCI. Students may choose which end date fits their schedule better, either August 7 or 18. A \$200.00 fine may be assessed to those who leave the program earlier than the end date to which they commit. Students must commit to remaining in Colorado for the entire program—participating in orientation camping trip, all Monday night sessions, and small group activities. Any exceptions must be discussed and agreed upon with the Program Director.

For summer 2012 there is a \$30.00 application fee to the program. This fee is used in part to provide group events at the beginning and end of the program. Students not selected will be reimbursed their application fee. Please attach a check payable to Calvin College with your application, or indicate that you prefer to have your miscellaneous charge the application fee.
