### 1. Virtues & Attitudes

- Silence: awe, wonder, receptivity, astonishment at surprises
- Surrender: self-giving in both liturgy and in daily living
- Hospitality: "at homeness" with God, self, others

### 2. Convictions

- Worship/liturgy is primarily about God, not us.
- Worship/liturgy brings change in both self and world.
- Worship/liturgy is filled with dynamism as well as stasis.

### 3. Insights

- God is both immanent and transcendent.
- Good worship/liturgy requires preparation.
  - ✓ Living as faithful disciple of Jesus
  - ✓ Personal prayer
  - ✓ Looking ahead at aspects of liturgy
- Good worship/liturgy leads to spirituality: a way of living the divine in the fullness of humanity.
