Hi my name is Nary Kun and my husband's name is Parri. My husband and I have 2 small children. One of my girls is 3 years old. Her name is Esther and my other daughter is 8 months old and her name is Naomi. My husband teaches some children in a village that doesn't have a school. He teaches them how to read and write and also teaches them about God. My husband's monthly salary is not enough for us to live on. We always end up borrowing money towards the end of the month. We have borrowed a total of about \$500. It is impossible for us to pay back what we have borrowed. I can not go to work because I have to stay home and take care of my 2 children. So it is very difficult for us to survive day by day. Sometimes we have food to eat with rice and sometimes we just eat only rice.

Since Mrs. Kieng Heck gave us the opportunity to produce hand cut cards, we have enough to eat and even pay off all of our debts. Thank the Lord for this opportunity! Mrs. Heck is trying to find a way to market the cards. She is not able to have us make any more cards until more people place orders. Right now we are praying for people to order the cards! If this happens then I can continue my work again. Thank you for your help in purchasing these cards.
